BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$276,420 BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF ACQUISITION OF CUSTOM FITTED BALLISTIC SOFT BODY ARMOR VESTS (CP 3153.513)

The class of objects or purposes for which the bonds are authorized to be issued is the acquisition of custom fitted ballistic soft body armor vests, at the estimated maximum cost of \$276,420.

The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$276,420. State aid in the amount of \$138,210 is expected to be received. The County Comptroller shall be limited to the issuance of bond anticipation notes for the \$138,210 State share.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is five (5) years.

It is proposed that the project will be implemented during 2015 and 2016 and that \$1,250,000 in sewer district serial bonds will be appropriated by 2014 with the first interest payment in 2015 and the maximum payment year being 2016 at a total cost of \$107,250 including increases in operation and maintenance.

There will be no fiscal impact to the benefited properties, since pursuant to the ASRF, all property owners in Suffolk County sewer districts experience a 3% annual increase regardless of any increases or improvements performed. In the case of Suffolk County Sewer District No. 9, the annual ASRF increase will result in an increase of approximately \$15.25 to the typical property within the District, regardless of the increase or improvement to facilities. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact caused to the benefited properties in the District as a result of the increase and improvement.

In the case of Suffolk County Sewer District No. 14, the annual ASRF increase will result in an increase of approximately \$9 per year per condominium and approximately \$11 per year per single family home, regardless of the increase or improvement. The public hearing is being held to address a proposed cost amendment to 2005 Map and Plan for the increase and improvement of the facilities of Sewer District No. 18 – Hauppauge Industrial and to extend the boundaries of said district.

The cost of the increase and improvement of the facilities of Sewer District No. 18 – Hauppauge Industrial and the extension of the boundaries of such district has risen from an estimated cost of \$65 million in 2005 to an estimated cost of \$82.7 million as set forth in the amended Map and Plan.

There will be no fiscal impact to the benefited properties within Suffolk County Sewer District No. 18 – Hauppauge Industrial, since pursuant to the Suffolk County Assessment Stabilization Reserve Fund (ASRF), all property owners in Suffolk County sewer districts experience a 3% annual increase regardless of any increases or improvements performed. In the case of Suffolk County Sewer District No. 18, the annual ASRF increase will result in an increase to approximately \$15.91 per 1,000 gallons to the typical property within the District, regardless of additional funds necessary to complete the increase and improvement and extension of boundaries. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact caused to the benefited properties in the District as a result of the amendment of the 2005 Map and Plan to reflect an increase in the cost to the increases, improvements, and extension of boundaries of the District.


