The work consists of the following:

Rehabilitation of two bridges spanning Long Island Railroad tracks - concrete deck scarifications; concrete deck and spall repairs, with installation of netting to bridge fascias to prevent debris fouling tracks below; installation of foam joints; milling and replacement of asphalt; placement of epoxy pavement markings.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.
