NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1726-2014 “A Charter Law to Update the County’s Ethics Statute” which law limits compensation for members of the Board of Ethics to \$4,800 per year as opposed to \$400 per month and allows the Board to meet at least once per month. This law also clarifies that the Board is authorized to impose a fine on persons who fail to file a financial disclosure statement as required under any section of Suffolk County law.
