NOTICE is hereby given that the Transportation Division (the Division) of the Suffolk County Department of Public Works intends to file an application with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) of the U.S. Department of Transportation for financial capital assistance for mass transportation projects for Suffolk County Transit. This financial assistance is being sought under Section 5307 of the Federal Transit Act (the Act).

- A. Program of Projects: Based upon the actual FTA Section 5307 apportionments to the New York-New Jersey NY-NJ-CT (UZA 1) and to the Bridgeport-Stamford CT-NY (UZA 42) Urbanized areas of Federal Fiscal Years 2012 (FFY '12) and 2013 (FFY '13) and upon agreement among the Section 5307 Designated Recipients of the New York portion of the Urbanized Areas, Suffolk County has been allocated \$6,269,032 for FFY '12 and \$6,418,882 for FFY '13.
