NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1859-2014 “A Local Law to Prohibit the Use of Unauthorized Tracking Devices” which law prohibits any person from installing or placing an electronic tracking device in or on a motor vehicle within Suffolk County without the knowledge and consent of all owners of the motor vehicle or track the location of a motor vehicle with an electronic device within Suffolk County without the knowledge and consent of all owners of the motor vehicle. Members of a law enforcement agency acting within the scope of their employment are exempt from this law. Violations of this law are punishable by up to one year in jail and fine of \$1,000.
