The work to be performed under this Contract consists of furnishing labor, supervision, safety measures, materials, tools, equipment and accessories, as may be required, for the proper execution and construction of pre-engineered storage metal building. The following is a general outline of work only and shall not be construed as complete description of the work to be performed under this Contract.

The principal features of the work to be performed under this single contract includes the construction of a pre-engineered metal storage building complete with lighting HVAC and fire alarm system as shown in the plans. The building foundation consists of a reinforced concrete mat slab supported by twenty pre-cast pre-stressed concrete piles as shown on the plans. The Contract includes pile installation and dynamic testing. The work also includes the installation of new utilities required for supplying power and system/phone line to the building as shown on the plans. Work also includes miscellaneous work including but not limited to foundation site work, restoration of existing storage building and various unit price and alternate items.

The project major components include but not limited to the following:

- A.** Construction of new pre-engineered steel storage building supported by a concrete mat and twenty pre-cast pre-stressed concrete piles. Building construction includes but not limited to all accessories, structural and electrical/ mechanical work and six galvanized steel overhead motor controlled roll up doors.
- B.** Existing butler building repairs including the replacement of damaged wall panels to match existing, replacement of all skylight panels, and removal of existing paint and re-painting of entire existing butler building with weather resistant coating.
- C.** Furnishing and installing hurricane shutters for high voltage equipment rooms at various locations throughout Bergen Point WWTP buildings including manual aluminum accordion windows hurricane shutters and manual aluminum roll down hurricane shutters based on unit price.

Note: This project will be bid as a single prime contract. This is a PLA (Project Labor Agreement) project. In accordance with "Wicks Reform 2008" bidders shall submit with their bids, a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each as applicable, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting (i.e., Plumbing Work), (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus (i.e., HVAC Work which includes fire sprinkler) and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures (i.e., Electrical Work). The apparent low bidder's subcontract information will be opened and read aloud at the bid opening.

A pre-bid conference and walk through will be conducted at the plant on **Thursday, April 30, 2015** at 9:00 AM.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Treasurer. This bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured. E-mailed bids will be considered unresponsive.

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person by the Bidder or his agent at the time and place stated.

The Eradication Plan shall address a method to effectively remove non-native plants and approximately 30,000 cubic yards of soft organic material to achieve a sand bottom. It is estimated that 4 to 6 acres would be required to properly dewater 30,000 cubic yards of material. This RFP also includes design of a construction plan to implement the Eradication Plan and construction oversight and inspection. This RFP does not cover the physical implementation (construction) of the Construction Plan.
