NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1260-2015 “A Local Law to Regulate “Board Up” Businesses in Suffolk County” which law requires “board up businesses” to: register with the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs; conform to federal Department of Housing and Urban Development standards for boarding and securing a property; stay behind fire lines; and comply with orders established by a fire marshal, fire department or police department. “Board Up Businesses” engaging in prohibitive acts, as defined, are subject to fines up to \$1,000. Licensed home improvement contractors and municipal employees boarding up structures are exempted from the requirements of this law.
