The estimate of the cost associated with the increase and improvement project is \$1.25 million. All property and property owners within said District are benefited by the increase and improvement.

Notice of Cost

The total cost for the increases and improvements to Suffolk County Sewer District No. 11 – Selden will be financed with funding sources including sewer district serial bonds and Assessment Stabilization Reserve Funds (ASRF). It is proposed that the project will be implemented during 2015 and that \$1.25 million in sewer district serial bonds will be appropriated in 2015.

There will be no fiscal impact to the benefited properties in the District inasmuch as the costs for the increase and improvement will be offset by, among other things, as the use of funds available in the Assessment Stabilization Reserve Fund.
