

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1751-2015 “A Local Law to Protect Public Safety in Suffolk County Parks” which law would require persons seeking to launch or land an unmanned aerial vehicle in any County park to obtain a permit from the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation. Unmanned aerial vehicles used by the federal and NYS government, local police, Suffolk County contractors, and persons holding an active media press pass issued by police departments of Nassau County, Suffolk County, and NYC are exempt from this law. Persons receiving a permit may only operate their unmanned aerial vehicle in those parks and park areas designated by the Department and only within such person’s line of sight. Violators of this law are subject to a civil penalty between \$250 and \$500, and, upon conviction, guilty of a misdemeanor.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the County Executive will hold a public hearing on the aforesaid Local Law at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time, on September 23, 2015 in Media Room 182, in the H. Lee Dennison Building, 100 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, New York 11788 at which time all interested persons will be heard.
