## **LEGAL NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1661-2015 “A Local Law to Prohibit the Sale of Personal Care Products Containing Microbeads” which law, effective January 1, 2018, prohibits the sale or offer for sale any personal care product which contains microbeads within the County of Suffolk. This prohibition does not apply to any personal care product that is regulated by the United States Food and Drug Administration until December 31, 2018 or in the case of over-the-counter drugs, until December 31, 2019. Violators of this law are subject to a civil fine up to \$500 for a first offense, \$750 for a second offense and \$1,000 for all subsequent violations.
