BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$99,871 BONDS TO FINANCE A PORTION OF THE COST OF PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN AUTOMATED VEHICLE LOCATER SYSTEM (AVL) FOR SUFFOLK COUNTY TRANSIT BUSES (CP 5648.524)
