BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW  
YORK, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$500,000 BONDS  
TO FINANCE THE COST OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO  
NEW AND EXISTING FACILITIES (CP 2153,310, 510)

The class of objects or purposes for which the bonds are authorized is to finance the cost of capital improvements to new and existing facilities including procurement of new furnishings, equipment and technology, as well as construction modifications within existing building spaces- to respond to evolving space needs and improvements to campus- hardscapes, at the estimated maximum cost of \$1,000,000.

The amount of obligations to be issued is \$500,000. State aid in the amount of \$500,000 is expected to be received.

The period of probable usefulness of the bonds is five (5) years.
