Suffolk County is proposing to eliminate 8 of the least used routes in the Suffolk County Transit bus system. Eliminating these routes will affect approximately 2% of daily ridership while saving \$4 million per year. In some cases there may be alternative bus routes for passengers and in some cases existing routes may be altered to cover key destinations on routes subject to elimination. Pending the outcome of the public hearings, route eliminations would begin on October 3rd, 2016.

The County is proposing that the following routes be eliminated:

1B, 5A, 7D/E, 10A, 10D/E, S35, S71, S90
