NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1649-2016 “A Local Law to Reduce the Use of Carryout Bags in Retail Sales” which law requires “covered stores” in Suffolk County to charge no less than .05 cents per carryout bag, provided to a customer, whether they are paper or plastic. A “covered store” is defined as any establishment engaged in the retail sale of consumer items including but not limited to drug stores, pharmacies, grocery stores, supermarkets, convenience stores, foodmarts, apparel stores, home center and hardware stores, stationery and office supply stores and food service establishments that are located in the aforementioned establishments. This law will become effective January 1, 2018. All fees collected by a covered store will be retained by that store. Violations of this law are punishable by a civil fine of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars for each violation.
