The work consists of the following:

Demolish existing accessory storage containers and deteriorating prefab trailer buildings. Construction of two new pre-engineered style insulated metal buildings at the Riverhead Correctional Facility. Each building will be 50 ft. x 100 ft. on reinforced concrete foundations with interior concrete slabs. Both buildings are to be located within the fenced, disturbed area of the Correctional Facility. Each building will be connected to the existing on-site utilities (gas, electric, water (add alt.) and sanitary sewer (add alt.)). As add alternates, each building shall contain one toilet facility which will be connected to the on-site sanitary sewer system. A pre-fabricated gate house and associated on-site utility work is part of additional add alternate bid items.
