NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1852-2016 “A Local Law Amending Chapter 77 of the Suffolk County Code to Clarify Application of the Suffolk County Ethics Code to Former County Employees” which law allows a former public servant to contract directly with the County to provide consultant services without violating the two year post-employment appearance ban. This law also allows former public servants of Suffolk County, who are hired by the County to provide consultant services, to appear before the County in relation to any particular matter in which such person had participated personally and substantially as a public servant.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the County Executive will hold a public hearing on the aforesaid Local Law at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time, on January 3, 2017 in Media Room 182, in the H. Lee Dennison Building, 100 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, New York 11788 at which time all interested persons will be heard.

LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suffolk County Legislature has passed Introductory Resolution No. 1890-2016 “A Local Law to Further Incentivize the Creation of Affordable Housing and to Clarify Requirements for Residential Developments Connecting to a Sewer District” which law reduces from 20% to 15%, the percentage of the total number of units which must be designated as affordable housing units within a residential housing development (consisting of 10 or more units) before such development located outside the geographical boundaries of a County sewer district may connect to the County sewer district. Additionally, the affordable units must be constructed at the site of the development that is connecting to a County sewer district facility. This law also creates a fee reduction schedule which reduces the sewer connection fee based on the number of affordable housing units in a development.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the County Executive will hold a public hearing on the aforesaid Local Law at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time, on January 3, 2017 in Media Room 182, in the H. Lee Dennison Building, 100 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, New York 11788 at which time all interested persons will be heard.
