The work consists of the following: Construction of a sanitary pumping station and force main and gravity sewer piping systems for the proposed Ronkonkoma Hub Development. Work also involves the removal and reconstruction of certain existing storm water drainage systems to accommodate construction of the force main and gravity sewer piping systems.

**CONTRACT NO.1 - GENERAL CONSTRUCTION – CP 8156**

Note: This is a PLA Project. This Project is to be bid as a single prime project. Bidders shall submit with their bids, a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each as applicable, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting (i.e., Plumbing Work), (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus (i.e., HVAC Work which includes fire sprinkler) and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures (i.e., Electrical Work). The apparent low bidder's subcontract information will be opened and read aloud at the bid opening.

Please note that the Suffolk County Department of Public Works will be receiving funding for this project by a grant from the New York Empire State Development.

A Pre-Bid walk-through is scheduled for **Monday May, 22, 2017 at 10:00 am** and commencing at the proposed Pumping Station site located on Mill Rd. south of Union Blvd. in Ronkonkoma. This is east of the Ronkonkoma RR Station. Contractors can visit the force main and gravity sewer routing on their own time, if desired.

The Contractor shall provide a description of contractor's experience, together with documentary evidence with projects of comparative size, complexity, and cost as a Prime Sewer Installation Contractor within the past five years, and shall be able to demonstrate the ability and capacity to perform, with his own organization, Contract Work amounting to not less than 50 percent of the original total Contract Price. Award of contract shall be contingent on submission and review of this experience which must be submitted with the Bid Form. Failure to submit this documentation will render you as a non-responsible bidder.

Bids for this contract shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with the name of the contract clearly noted on the outside of the envelope. Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total Base Bid, made payable to the Suffolk County Comptroller. This bid bond will be held as a guarantee that in the event the bid is accepted and contract awarded to the Bidder, the contract will be duly executed and properly secured. **E-MAILED BIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED UNRESPONSIVE.**

Awards will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder in conjunction with Section A4-14 of the Suffolk County Administrative Code establishing an optional ten percent (10%) local (Nassau/Suffolk) preference program for Suffolk County contracts.

The bids shall be delivered in person, by the Bidder or his agent, at the time and place stated.
