Gregory Statement on Wyandanch Murders

HAUPPAUGE, N.Y – Suffolk County Legislature Presiding Officer DuWayne Gregory today issued the following statement on the shootings in Wyandanch that killed three young people and injured another:

“My condolences go out to the families who are mourning the loss of loved ones in these senseless shootings. There is no way to assuage their grief. This kind of violence is a heartbreaking tragedy that damages our entire community.

“Suffolk County Police continue their investigation of the shootings. Police say the violence may have been gang-related, which could discourage potential witnesses from coming forward. Residents who might have information on these crimes can call Crime Stoppers at 1-800-220-TIPS to leave an anonymous message. You can also text “SCPD” and your message to CRIMES (274637). A \$3,000 reward is being offered for information that leads to arrests for these shootings.”
