The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1688** –mandating compliance with Financial Disclosure Requirements. (Cooper) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1782** –to register pre-paid cell phones purchased in Suffolk County. (Browning) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1834** –to standardize home energy audits in Suffolk County. (Horsley) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1863** –to reduce minors' access to spray paint. (Browning) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1866** –to register Non-Profit Veterans Organizations in Suffolk County. (Cilmi) was **closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature's *Veterans & Seniors Committee*.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1878** –to ensure the safe transfer of fuel to boats and watercraft in the Peconic Estuary. (Schneiderman) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1880**–Proposed increase and improvement of facilities for Sewer District No. 3 – Southwest (Expansion) (CP8183) (Co. Exec.) was **closed**.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1882** – Proposed increase and improvement of facilities for Sewer District No. 3 – Southwest (Infiltration/Inflow) (CP 8181) was **closed**.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1883** –declaring a surplus and authorizing the execution of contract for the sale of ~255 acres in Yaphank to Legacy Village Real Estate Group, LLC for mixed use development. (Co. Exec.) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1873** – Proposed increase and improvement of the Sewer Collection System Facilities for Sewer District No. 7 – Medford (CP8150) (Co. Exec.) was **closed**.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1874** - Proposed increase and improvement of Wastewater Treatment Facilities for Sewer District No. 14 Parkland (CP8118) (Co. Exec.) was **closed**.

The Public Hearing on **I.R. 1916** –to ensure the safe use of air guns in Suffolk County. (Eddington) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature's Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1923 –to increase public confidence in government by amending the Nepotism Provisions of the Suffolk County Code. (Co. Exec.) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Ways & Means Committee*.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1939 –to require homeless sex offenders to report their overnight locations. (Eddington) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Public Safety Committee*.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1947 –to sunset Living Wage Subsidies. (Cilmi) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1949 –to protect children from cadmium poisoning. (Co. Exec.) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Health & Human Services committee*.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1950 –strengthening the Social Host Law to deter the consumption of alcohol by minors within the Suffolk County Park System. (Co. Exec.) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1952 –to protect animals in Suffolk County from abuse. (Cooper) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s Nov. 3rd General Mtg.

The Public Hearing on I.R. 1972 – Transfer of funds from the Tax Stabilization Reserve Fund to the Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund. (Lindsay) (Procedural Motion 23) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Budget & Finance Committee*.
