IR 1922 Amending the 2010 Operating Budget and transferring funds within the Police Department to fund additional surveillance cameras in the Town of Huntington. (Cooper) **TABLED 16-0-0-2**

IR 2004 Appropriating funds for the study and monitoring of public health related harmful algal blooms (CP 8224). (Co. Exec.) **APPROVED 15-2-0-1**

IR 2044 Making a recommendation concerning adoption of the Final Scope for the draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement for the declaration as surplus and subsequent sale of 255± acres of County owned land in Yaphank for mixed use development purposes, Town of Brookhaven. (Pres. Off.) **APPROVED 13-4-0-1**

IR 1949 A Local Law to protect children from cadmium poisoning. (Co. Exec.) **APPROVED 17-0-0-1**

IR 2035 Directing the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council to prepare a report on supportive housing options for individuals in recovery. (Browning)

Public Hearings **The Public Hearing on I.R. 1866** –to register Non-Profit Veterans Organizations in Suffolk County. (Cilmi) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Veterans & Seniors Committee*.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1408 –to increase Legislative Oversight of RFP Process. (Romaine) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1782 –to register pre-paid cell phones purchased in Suffolk County. (Browning) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1834 –to standardize home energy audits in Suffolk County. (Horsley) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Consumer Protection Committee*

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1863 –to reduce minors’ access to spray paint. (Browning) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Public Safety Committee*

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1883 –declaring a surplus and authorizing the execution of contract for the sale of ~255 acres in Yaphank to Legacy Village Real Estate Group, LLC for mixed use development. (Co. Exec.) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1916 –to ensure the safe use of air guns in Suffolk County. (Eddington) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1947 –to sunset Living Wage Subsidies. (Cilmi) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1950 –strengthening the Social Host Law to deter the consumption of alcohol by minors within the Suffolk County Park System. (Co. Exec.) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1952 –to protect animals in Suffolk County from abuse. (Cooper) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.

The Public Hearing for I.R. 1976 –to broaden eligibility for senior citizen tax exemption. (Stern) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Veterans & Seniors committee*

- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2010** –to strengthen the Social Host Law in Suffolk County. (Cilmi) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Public Safety committee*
- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2013** –to establish minimum standards for breath alcohol ignition interlock devices. (D’Amaro) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Public Safety Committee*
- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2018** –to promote the preservation and integrity of the Pine Barrens Core Area by prohibiting the redemption or conveyance of vacant or unimproved Pine Barrens Core parcels acquired by Suffolk County by tax deed. (Co. Exec.) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.
- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2034** - establishing a Food Policy Council for Suffolk County. (Viloria-Fisher) was **recessed**, the public hearing will be continued at the Legislature’s December 7th General Mtg.
- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2037** –to expand the scope of the County’s Social Host Law. (Montano) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Public Safety Committee*
- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2054** –**authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements for the sale of the John J. Foley Skilled Nursing Facility.** (Co. Exec.) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Health & Human Services Committee*
- The Public Hearing for I.R. 2055** –to require the appropriate use of taxpayer monies for funded positions. (Viloria-Fisher) was **Closed**, the bill will now go before the Legislature’s *Ways & Means Committee*
