IR 2073 Establishing an automated calling policy prior to distributing rabies baits in Suffolk County. (Stern)
IR 2105 Authorizing and directing the Department of Social Services to enter into agreement to house sex offenders. (Romaine)
IR 1863 to reduce minors' access to spray paint. (Browning)
IR 1939 to require Homeless Sex Offenders to report their overnight locations. (Eddington)
IR 2013 to establish minimum standards for Breath Alcohol Ignition Interlock Devices. (D'Amaro)
IR 2010 to strengthen the Social Host Law in Suffolk County. (Cilmi)

I.R. 2018 –to promote the preservation and integrity of the Pine Barrens Core Area by prohibiting the redemption or conveyance of vacant or unimproved Pine Barrens Core parcels acquired by Suffolk County by tax deed. (Co. Exec.) *Ways & Means*

I.R. 2034 - establishing a Food Policy Council for Suffolk County. (Viloria-Fisher) *H&HS*
