(Smithtown, NY)...At the November 4 special meeting of the Suffolk County Legislature, Legislator Lynne C. Nowick invited Father Tony Stangnaelli, pastor of Sts. Philip and James Roman Catholic Church, to say the invocation. Each legislator is assigned a date by the Presiding Officer to invite a member of the clergy from his or her district to say the opening prayer for each General Meeting of the Legislature and to provide breakfast.

Father Tony was appointed pastor in June of 2008. He was ordained a priest in March of 1979 and has served as an Associate Pastor in Our Lady of Lourdes in West Islip, St. Edwards's in Syosset, St. Catherine of Sienna in Franklin Square and St. Philip Neri in Northport. Prior to his present appointment, he was Pastor of Holy Spirit in New Hyde Park.

Legislator Lynne C. Nowick represents the 13th Legislative District, which includes Smithtown, Fort Salonga, Kings Park, San Remo, Nissequogue, Head of the Harbor, and St. James, as well as portions of Commack and East Northport. Legislator Nowick chairs the Labor, Workforce and Affordable Housing Committee and serves on the Ways and Means and Parks and Recreation Committees. She is also a member of the County Executive's Budget Working Group and Suffolk County Workforce Housing Commission.
