**LEGISLATOR D'AMARO JOINS BUSINESS LEADERS
AT UNVEILING OF HUNTINGTON ATRIUM MURAL**

Legislator Lou D'Amaro (D-Huntington Station) recently joined local business and community leaders at the unveiling of a 460 square-foot mosaic mural now gracing the entry-way of the Huntington Atrium business condominium at 775 Park Avenue in Huntington. The astonishing robot-produced mural is of a Seafarer 48 yacht, similar to ones built by Seafarer Fiberglass Yachts in Huntington, which was formerly located on the site that now houses the Huntington Atrium. Designed by Ted Acworth of Artaic (www.artaic.com) from an original watercolor painted for the Seafarer brochure, the mural incorporates 368,371 individual tiles, making it the largest 3/8" tile mosaic ever produced by a robot. A boat similar to the one depicted was named "Queen of the Show" at the 1969 New York Boat Show.

"This beautiful mural brings yesterday and today together by using the latest technology to give us a window into our past," said Legislator D'Amaro. "It is a wonderful anchor to both the Huntington Atrium and the town and I urge local residents to visit the Atrium to view this breathtaking mosaic in person."
