BROWNING KEYNOTE SPEAKER AT PATTERSQUASH CREEK CIVIC

Quality of Life Issues Focus of Discussion

Mastic Beach, NY – Legislator Kate Browning (WF-Shirley) was the guest speaker at the Pattersquash Creek Civic Association’s August 1, 2011 meeting. Residents living in the newly formed Village of Mastic Beach asked Legislator Browning many questions regarding quality of life issues in the area and her work as their Suffolk County Legislator.

Among the topics covered were substandard housing, sex offender clusters, sober homes, health concerns at the Track gas station, environmental preservation, dredging of the peninsula, police issues and projects to improve activities for our youth.

“It was a pleasure to visit with the Pattersquash Creek Civic Association and the residents of Mastic Beach Village,” stated Legislator Browning. “It was informative and helpful to hear their concerns about the quality of life in the area. I was happy to update them on the positive effects of the quarter mile residency restrictions for sex offenders and the sober home oversight program I have implemented. There is never a shortage of issues in the area that need to be addressed and I will continue to work with the newly formed village to improve the quality of life for its residents.”
