Browning Urges Parents to Utilize Free Drug Kits Offered By Sheriff DeMarco

Mastic, NY – The Suffolk County Sheriff’s “Test, Don’t Guess” program is providing free drug kits to assist parents and guardians with privately monitoring the behavior of children who are under the age of 18. Legislator Kate Browning (WF-Shirley), who chairs the Public Safety Committee, is helping to educate families of the program in hopes that they can take advantage of it before more children fall victim to the drug epidemic on Long Island.

Free drug test kits can be picked up at Suffolk County Sheriff Vincent DeMarco’s offices in Riverhead and Yaphank. Only 2 kits may be picked up at a time.

“This is an important program that provides parents with the privacy that other options simply do not offer,” stated Legislator Browning. “I want to thank Sheriff DeMarco for making this available to residents. If you are concerned about your child and are suspicious they may be using drugs, I urge you to take advantage of this free kit. We have a major drug epidemic on Long Island and this can assist in addressing the situation before it is too late.”
