Legislator Browning Supports William Floyd NJROTC Drive Benefiting Our Troops Overseas

Shirley, NY – The William Floyd NJROTC held a supplies drive for troops serving overseas on Saturday, November 8. Members set up donation tables outside of two CVS's in Shirley and Mastic. Legislator Kate Browning (WF-Shirley) joined the effort to thank the NJROTC for their work in support of our troops and to make a donation to the cause.

The supplies collected from the drive are given to “Boots on the Ground NY”, a non-profit veteran’s organization that helps homeless veterans here at home and supports our troops overseas. As of October 2014, the organization already shipped over 2130 boxes just in 2014 to our troops serving in harm’s way. The donations collected on Saturday will be a part of these military care packages.
