Bellport, NY – Legislator Kate Browning (WF-Shirley) celebrated with the Miranda family as officials dedicated their new home in Bellport. The project was made possible through a partnership with Suffolk County and Habitat for Humanity.

The property at 715 Walker Ave. in Bellport was another tax lien parcel that Suffolk County transferred to the Town of Brookhaven through its 72-h program. The program continues to prevent speculation on future rentals, and provides middle-class families with an opportunity to achieve the American dream. Had the property not been transferred to the Town, it would have been auctioned off to the highest bidder.
