### **Legislator Muratore Announces February Immunization Action Program (IAP)**

**Selden, NY** – Legislator Tom Muratore would like to inform residents that the Suffolk County Department of Health is offering recommended immunizations for children. The Immunization Action Program (IAP) is geared toward uninsured children and children whose health insurance will not cover immunizations. Also known as “Shots for Tots” this program offers immunizations for low-cost or for free.



There are two upcoming events in the Fourth Legislative District. The first is February 7 at the Middle Country Library located at 575 Middle Country Road in Selden between 3:00 pm and 6:15 pm. The second is February 28 at the Sachem Library located at 150 Holbrook Road in Holbrook from 3:00 pm to 6:15 pm. Parents must bring the child's immunization records.

Parents are encouraged to call the Suffolk County Health Services to receive information on how to get their children vaccinated. The office can be reached by phone at (631) 853-8496.
