**RESOLUTION NO. -2012, TO REDUCE THE PRINTING
COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE COUNTY'S DIRECT
DEPOSIT PAYMENT SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the County of Suffolk pays a large number of employees through the use of direct deposit into the employee's bank account; and

WHEREAS, County employees paid through direct deposit generally receive a printed document detailing their payment and withholdings; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature has recently implemented a system in which employees paid through direct deposit receive their payment information via County email in a PDF document, eliminating printing costs; and

WHEREAS, other departments throughout the County should convert to an emailed direct deposit slip format, creating a significant recurring cost savings to the County; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that all employees who elect to receive payment via direct deposit shall receive their bi-weekly payment information through the County email system; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this requirement shall not apply to County employees who do not have a County email address; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that departments shall have until April 1, 2012 to implement these requirements; and be it further

4th RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
