**RESOLUTION NO. 213 -2013, TO APPOINT MEMBER TO
THE FOOD POLICY COUNCIL OF SUFFOLK COUNTY (ERIN
LEIGH THORESEN)**

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 11-2011 established a Food Policy Council of Suffolk County consisting of 16 members; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 644-2011 appointed Donna Boyce as a member of the Food Policy Council as one of the two representatives of community-based groups; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that Erin Leigh Thoresen, Senior Program Coordinator of Sustainable Long Island, is hereby appointed to the Food Policy Council of Suffolk County as one of the two representatives from a community-based group, to complete the unexpired term of Donna Boyce, said term of office to expire August 29, 2014, pursuant to Section 3(A)(9) of Local Law No. 11-2011; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
