

**RESOLUTION NO. 225 -2013, DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF  
TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, TO  
PROMOTE 511NY.ORG FOR PLANNING PUBLIC  
TRANSPORTATION ROUTES**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Suffolk operates public transit to allow for affordable travel throughout the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New York established a website to encourage the use of public transit systems throughout the state, 511ny.org; and

**WHEREAS**, 511ny.org provides for planning public transportation from any point within Suffolk County to any point in the State; and

**WHEREAS**, 511ny.org can be accessed on computers as well as mobile smartphones; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division of Transportation in the Department of Public Works should link to 511ny.org on the County's public transportation website and promote the use of 511ny.org as an aid in planning trips via public transportation; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the Division of Transportation in the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to provide a hyperlink to 511ny.org on all websites associated with public transportation in Suffolk County; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that the Division of Transportation is further directed to develop and implement a public education campaign to raise awareness of 511ny.org among public transportation users and Suffolk County as a whole; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that the public education campaign shall be implemented within ninety days of the effective date of this resolution; and be it further

**4th RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
