

RESOLUTION NO. 340 -2013, TO APPOINT MEMBER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION (J. EDWARD SHILLINGBURG)

WHEREAS, Sections C35-3 and C35-4 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER provide for the appointment of fifteen (15) members of the Suffolk County Planning Commission, one member from each of the ten (10) towns in Suffolk County, one member from an incorporated village of under 5,000 population, one member from an incorporated village of over 5,000 population, and three members from the County at large; and

WHEREAS, the representative for the Town of Shelter Island, Linda Holmes, is vacating her position effective May 2, 2013, which term is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2013 (Resolution No. 1185-2009); and

WHEREAS, Steven Bellone, the County Executive of Suffolk has appointed J. Edward Shillingburg, currently residing in Shelter Island Heights, New York 11965, as a member of the County Planning Commission representing the Town of Shelter Island; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that J. Edward Shillingburg, currently residing in Shelter Island Heights, NY 11965, is hereby appointed as a member of the Suffolk County Planning Commission representing the Town of Shelter Island for the remainder of the vacated term, said term to expire December 31, 2013, pursuant to Sections C35-3 and C35-4 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
