RESOLUTION NO. 538 -2013, AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 118-2013 TO INCLUDE ACTIVE MILITARY IN GOLF FEE PILOT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 118-2013 established a pilot program to charge veterans golfing fees equivalent to those paid by seniors; and

WHEREAS, the pilot program should be amended to include active duty members of the Armed Forces; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the pilot program established by Resolution No. 118-2013 shall be extended so as to offer active duty members of the Armed Forces a discounted golf fee equivalent to the fee paid by veterans during the term of the pilot program; and be it further

2rd RESOLVED, that the amendment to the County's golf fee schedule enacted herein shall expire on March 11, 2014, unless extended by a subsequent resolution of the County of Suffolk; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
