**RESOLUTION NO. 526 -2014, REAPPOINTING MEMBER TO
THE SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF
TRUSTEES (ANNE SHYBUNKO-MOORE)**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 380-2012 appointed **Anne Shybunko-Moore** to the Board of Trustees of the Suffolk County Community College for a term to expire on June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Community College advised this Legislature by a letter dated May 27, 2014 that **Anne Shybunko-Moore** was absent from four (4) consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees; therefore, pursuant to § C23-3 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, her seat on the Board of Trustees is deemed vacant; and

WHEREAS, this Legislature determines that at least one of Ms. Shybunko-Moore's absences could have been excused for just cause; and

WHEREAS, **Ms. Shybunko-Moore** wishes to remain on the College's Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, **Ms. Shybunko-Moore** has proven to be an effective advocate for the College; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that **Anne Shybunko-Moore** of Hauppauge, NY 11788 is hereby re-appointed as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Suffolk County Community College, pursuant to Section 6306(1) of the New York Education Law, said term to expire on June 30, 2019; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
