RESOLUTION NO. 839 -2014, APPROVING A TEMPORARY INCREASE TO THE FLEET FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S NARCOTICS SECTION AT NO COST TO THE COUNTY THROUGH THE USE OF TASK FORCE REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, The United States Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Service, made \$60,000 available to Suffolk County for the participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the IRS Suffolk-Treasury Enhanced Prosecution Program (STEPP) task force; and

WHEREAS, the above stated funding was accepted by Adopted Resolution No. 1140-2013; and

WHEREAS, by Adopted Resolution No.1140-2013 and pursuant to the Agreement and Funding Document between the Suffolk County Police and the Internal Revenue Service, \$10,000 was allocated to Travel and \$50,000 to Personnel Services; and

WHEREAS, The Internal Revenue Service upon request of the Suffolk County Police Department has approved the reallocation of \$5,000 of the \$10,000 Travel allocation to the lease of a vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Detective assigned to the IRS STEPP Task Force 2014 requires an undercover vehicle in order to perform the duties required by the Task Force such as surveillance; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Police Department is given authorization to temporarily increase the Police fleet by one vehicle (undercover vehicles to be determined), which lease will be funded through IRS STEPP Task Force funds.
