**RESOLUTION NO. 823 -2014, TO APPOINT MEMBER TO THE  
FOOD POLICY COUNCIL OF SUFFOLK COUNTY (MEGHAN  
ASHFORD-GROOMS)**

**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 11-2011 established a Food Policy Council of Suffolk County consisting of 17 members; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of office of Gwen O'Shea as one of the representatives from a community based group expired May 20, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, this Legislature wishes to appoint Meghan Ashford-Grooms to fill this vacant position; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that Meghan Ashford-Grooms is hereby appointed to the Food Policy Council of Suffolk County as one of the two representatives from a community based group, for a term of office to expire May 20, 2017, pursuant to Section 101-4 of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
