**RESOLUTION NO. 933 -2014, AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF  
DEVELOPMENT CREDITS TO WESTHAMPTON FREE  
LIBRARY**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 812-2011, as amended by Resolution No. 217-2012, authorizes the County to transfer development rights credits to library, fire, ambulance and police districts to construct or expand their facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Westhampton Free Library wishes to build out the attic space of their library to add approximately 2,500 sq. feet of additional library space for expanded patron usage; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to move forward with this project, the Library requires an additional 75 GPD of flow or .25 credits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Library has applied to the Department of Economic Development and Planning for the transfer of the necessary credits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health Services has identified the appropriate sending parcel for the required area; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the Department of Economic Development and Planning and the Department of Health Services, acting through their Commissioners or their respective designees, are each hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take all necessary and appropriate steps to transfer a .25 development credit from a sending parcel identified as SCTM No. 0900-356.00-02.00-001.006 to the Westhampton Free Library property identified as SCTM No. 0905-011.00-02.00-030.000 and 031.000 without consideration therefor; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that the development credits shall be utilized solely for the municipal purposes set forth herein; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
