**RESOLUTION NO. 976 -2014, REAPPOINT MEMBER TO THE
SUFFOLK COUNTY BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PARKS,
RECREATION, AND CONSERVATION (KATHLEEN GOODING)**

WHEREAS, §28-1(C) of the Suffolk County Charter establishes the Board of Trustees of Parks, Recreation and Conservation; and

WHEREAS, each of the ten towns in Suffolk County shall have a representative recommended by the Supervisor to serve a five-year term as Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor of Shelter Island has requested that Kathleen Gooding be reappointed to the Board as her current term of office expires on November 30, 2014; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that Kathleen Gooding from Shelter Island, NY, be and she hereby is reappointed, pursuant to Section 28-1(C) of the Suffolk County Charter, as a member of the Suffolk County Board of Trustees of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation as the representative of the Town of Shelter Island, for a term of office to expire on November 30, 2019; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
