**RESOLUTION NO. 284 -2015, APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH FIRE RESCUE C.A.D. SYSTEM UPGRADES (CP 3416)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services has requested funds for the purchase and installation of new communication equipment at multiple current tower sites; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2015 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said purchase and installation under Capital Program Number 3416; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system of capital projects as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, amortizing the bonds over the period of probable usefulness ("PPU") of the purchase of equipment for C.A.D. system upgrades may be fiscally beneficial as compared to including the items in the weighted average maturity ("WAM") determined for a typical bond issue; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$750,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that Suffolk County, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(C), (25) and (27) as this legislative decision involves the purchase of furnishings, equipment or supplies other than the following: land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials; as such, this Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-four (54) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Department of Fire, Rescue & Emergency Services is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary, pursuant to Section C11-3(15) and (16) respectively of the Suffolk County Charter to complete this project; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup> RESOLVED**, that if it is determined to be fiscally beneficial, the equipment for C.A.D. system upgrades will be financed utilizing the PPU of the equipment; and be it further

**5<sup>th</sup> RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of the \$750,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
