

**RESOLUTION NO. 509 -2015, ACCEPTING FTA FFY 2012 SECTION 5316 JOB ACCESS AND REVERSE COMMUTE (JARC) FUNDS FOR THE PROVISION OF SUNDAY BUS SERVICE FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY TRANSIT BUS SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 366-2013 authorized the filing of a grant with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) grant funds to expand bus services in Suffolk County in the evening and on Sundays; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County has been awarded \$3,965,934 in JARC funds by the FTA; and

**WHEREAS**, the \$3,965,934 will cover three years of funding, reimbursing the County \$1,321,978 per year beginning in County FY 2014 and going through 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County can use these funds to offset up to 50% of the cost of the provision of Sunday bus service for the Suffolk County Transit Bus System; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County shall include in its 2014, 2015, and 2016 Operating Budgets sufficient funds to cover the operating expenses of the Sunday bus program; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County shall include in its 2014, 2015, and 2016 Operating Budgets projected revenue estimates in the amount of \$3,965,934 in Revenue Code 001-DPW-5631-4596; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the County Treasurer and the County Comptroller are authorized to accept Federal Aid in connection with this project.
