RESOLUTION NO. 868 -2015, AUTHORIZING THE ILLUMINATION OF THE H. LEE DENNISON EXECUTIVE OFFICE BUILDING IN RECOGNITION OF ALVEOLAR CAPILLARY DYSPLASIA AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 152-2012 the Department of Public Works is authorized to illuminate the H. Lee Dennison Building during the month of October with a pink glow during the month of October as part of the Breast Cancer Awareness Program; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 152-2012 further provided that the Department of Public Works could change the lighting at the H. Lee Dennison Building during October if different lighting is specifically authorized by separate resolution; and

WHEREAS, Alveolar Capillary Dysplasia is a rare disease resulting in a developmental anomaly of the pulmonary vasculature, impeding the exchange of oxygen and carbon dioxide in a complex developmental disability that affects an individual's social interaction and communication; and

WHEREAS, in honor of Fallon Jade Rilling, a Suffolk County resident who was diagnosed with Alveolar Capillary Dysplasia and who succumbed to the symptoms associated with this fatal disease; and

WHEREAS, public awareness of the condition is a key component to increased education and scientific research of this fatal condition, its causes, and the search for potential cures; and

WHEREAS, to further raise the public's awareness of Alveolar Capillary Dysplasia, Suffolk County wishes to participate in an illumination project to express support for those afflicted with Alveolar Capillary Dysplasia, their families and caregivers; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 8-2(W) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER to illuminate the north side of the H. Lee Dennison Executive Office Building facing Veterans Memorial Highway with a purple glow on October 10th, beginning in 2015 and continuing every year thereafter; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
