**RESOLUTION NO. 950 -2016, AMENDING THE 2016 ADOPTED CAPITAL BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY COASTAL RESILIENCY INITIATIVE, PATCHOGUE RIVER NITROGEN REDUCTION PROJECT (CP 8196) AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. Suffolk County has been awarded funds by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (“DEC”) for planning and design costs for the Patchogue River component of the Suffolk County Coastal Resiliency Initiative (“SCCRI”); and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County has been awarded funds by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (“DEC”) for planning and design costs for the Patchogue River component of the Suffolk County Coastal Resiliency Initiative (“SCCRI”); and

**WHEREAS**, the grant period for this award is April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the County will enter into a Grant Agreement with DEC (Exhibit “A”, “Grant Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the County must “first instance fund” projects costs and subsequently receive reimbursement from the DEC; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system of capital projects as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the DEC grant funds have not been included within the 2016 Capital Budget and Program; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that Suffolk County, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(20)(27) as this legislative decision involves the routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment and, as such, this Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of sixty-three (63) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that the 2016 Capital Budget and Program be and they are hereby amended as follows:
